We are the Volunteer Fire Assn. of Tappan and we protect the Tappan Fire District in Rockland County, New York. Our district includes residential and commercial areas in Tappan, and parts of Orangeburg and Sparkill. At times of emergency, we respond 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, and we are proudly 100% staffed by volunteers.

This year the fire district has purchased a new fire apparatus. This apparatus is a 2023 Seagrave 75' Meanstick, which is designed to respond to all types of emergencies. It is customary by fire departments to celebrate this occasion with a "wet down" ceremony. The wet down will be held on Saturday, September 28, 2024, from 2PM to 9PM at our Washington St. firehouse. This event will be attended by our firefighters, firefighters from other districts, as well as the community.

This event will be very costly to our Department. All money that will be used has and will only come from our neighbors and businesses through donations. We are asking our local neighbors and businesses to show their support by requesting a monetary donation.
